ACCOUNT TERMINATION AUTHORIZATION

Instructions:

- This WREGIS Account Termination Authorization should be completed, signed and submitted by an Account Holder at least sixty (60) days prior to the date on which Account Holder wants to terminate its WREGIS Account.
- Submission of this Account Termination Authorization will result in termination of the Account Holder's WREGIS Account and Subaccounts. It will *not* automatically terminate the Account Holder Registration Agreement (also known as the "Terms of Use") between WREGIS and the Account Holder. If Account Holder wants to voluntarily terminate the Account Holder Registration Agreement, the Account Holder must separately provide written notice to WECC as required under Section 10.c of the Agreement, and comply with all other applicable requirements.
- Account termination will be subject to the terms and conditions in the Account Holder Registration Agreement and the WREGIS Operating Rules. Account Holder's obligation to pay any WREGIS fees and any other outstanding obligation will survive termination of Account Holder's WREGIS Account.
- It is the Account Holder's responsibility to ensure that Generating Units are re-registered in another Account prior to terminating the Account Holder's WREGIS Account. Any Generating Unit that is not re-registered before termination of the Account Holder's Account will not be entitled to create or transfer WREGIS Certificates until it has re-registered with WREGIS. It is also the Account Holder's responsibility to address the disposition of any Certificates remaining in the Account for which termination is authorized. The Account Holder must specify the Account and Active Subaccount to which any remaining Certificates that have not yet been issued should be deposited. Any fractional MWhs (i.e. any kWhs) left on the generation activity log at the time of de-registration will be forfeited. WREGIS will not accept prior period adjustments after an Account is closed.
- Account termination will be effective upon the WREGIS Administrator's acknowledgement by email correspondence or by online completion of the Account termination unless Account Holder specifies a termination date below.
